Amen.

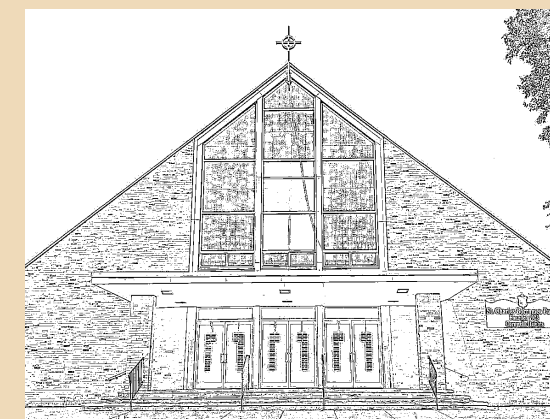
Prayer for the Eucharistic Revival
