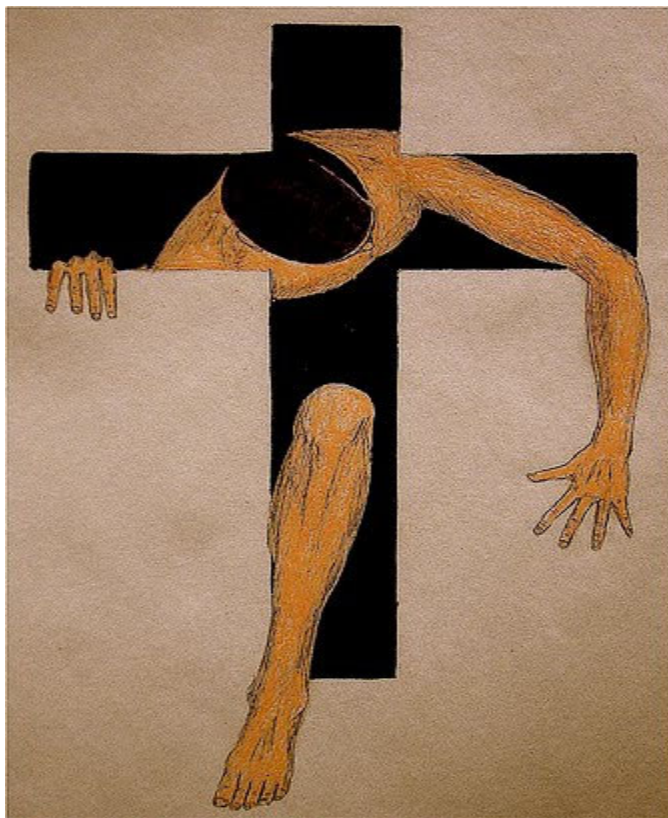

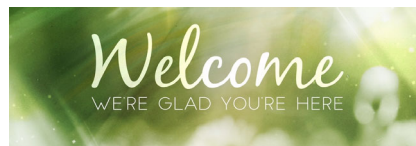

**How does one become Catholic or receive the Sacraments as an Adult?**

Do you know anybody who is attracted to Catholicism? Or has a restless heart and is seeking answers to questions like, “why am I here?” and “what is the purpose of my life?” Are you a non-Catholic spouse or friend of a Catholic and have ever considered becoming Catholic? Were you baptized or received First Holy Communion but never Confirmed? Do you think something is missing in your life? The O.C.I.A (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) addresses the fundamental questions that arise from the human experience while providing an introduction to the Catholic faith for persons inquiring about or desiring to become Catholic. The course may also serve as instruction and formation in the faith for adult Catholics who lack any of the sacraments. The course is less about doctrine or catechism and more about learning to grow in friendship with Christ through reading of Sacred Scripture, participation in the Mass, and a shared journey within the community of the Church. Sessions take place Monday evenings from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. Questions or inquiries can be directed to Fr. **O.C.I.A “Team Members” wanted!** The model that Jesus gave us for passing on the faith - our relationship with Him - is not through the Catechism and a set of moral norms, but by “sharing life” with others. Jesus didn’t say, “read this” or “learn this” but “Come and see” and “follow me” (John 1: 39, 43). The disciples came to discover the meaning of their lives and that Jesus was the Savior through the experience of their friendship with him and by staying with him even when they didn’t understand what Jesus was saying. Jesus continues to attract and form disciples through this same method today through his mystical body, the Church. What is needed are not teachers but witnesses - people who demonstrate by their “way” of life that their relationship with Christ is what gives life, all of life, “life” - fullness, meaning, purpose, and direction. If you are interested in journeying with those who have become awakened by an encounter with Christ or are seeking a way for yourself to be renewed in your own relationship with the Lord and to see Him alive in the Church, please consider joining the O.C.I.A “Team”. 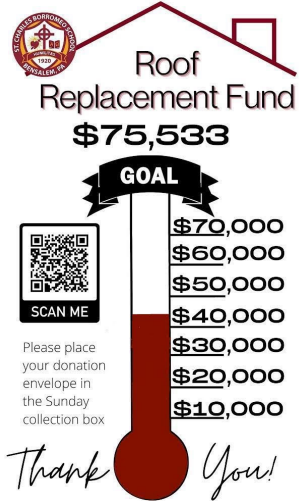
**A Car is needed**

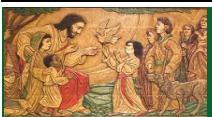

Baptisms will be celebrated in English at 2:00 p.m. on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month and during the 10:00 a.m. Mass on the 4th Sunday of the month. The date of the baptism can be set after baptismal preparation for parents and godparents and letters of eligibility for sponsors have been completed. 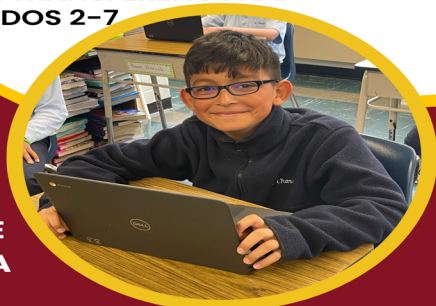

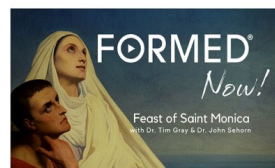

**MISSIONARY FRATERNITY OF MARY**



The Missionary Fraternity of Mary founded in 1985, amidst the chaos at the conclusion of a 35 years civil war and religious persecution, was established in Guatemala City to meet the religious and temporal needs of those who could least afford it.

Our mission in Guatemala began promoting vocations to priesthood, bringing the good news of Jesus to the marginalized in different areas of the country, later on, God blessed us expanding our mission to other countries with a missionary spirit.

The Missionary Fraternity of Mary is a Society of Religious life with diocesan right within the Roman Catholic Church dedicated to educating and ordaining young men to bring the good news and the sacraments to the marginalized Catholics of the world. As Missionaries, we are dedicated to the needs of the poor, promoting vocations to religious life, prepare youth for lay ministry within the Church.

The Mother-house of the Fraternity it is located in Guatemala City, Central America.

This year, we have 65 seminarians in different levels of formation at our seminary in Guatemala City. 168 Missionary priests serving in 60 mission , 41 dioceses in 11 count ri es. Countries where the Fraternity has its missionary presence are: Panama, Peru, Ecuador, Venezuela, Honduras, Belize, Guatemala, Canada, Italy, Kenya and in the United States, (Diocese of San Bernardino California and Milwaukee Archdiocese.) We are committed to the Universal Church to continue forming young people to the priesthood, and to spread the good news to the poor. Our challenges are many, since we don't have a monthly or yearly financial support from any institution in the Catholic Church in Guatemala. For now, the pandemic has resulted in a significant reduction in worldwide mission appeals which has a serious impact on our budget for this year and the year to come. Our annual budget per seminarian is \$3,500. We seek funds to support our program of formation in the seminary in Guatemala, most of our students come from poor families and from Mayan background in Guatemala. As a result of the pandemic, at this time not all teachers can teach in person at the seminary. We had to implement new strategies in learning and teaching skills, we have improved the WIFI signal in our academic buildings at the seminary but still we need more improvements to continue to provide a high level of education for our seminarians; many of them come from remote areas in Guatemala where they don't have access to internet. We are also in great need to support our missions in Kenya, Peru and Venezuela. Thank you for your support to the Missionary Fraternity of Mary and to the Missions of the Universal Church. God bless you.

**FRATERNIDAD MISIONERA DE MARIA**

La Fraternidad Misionera de María fundada en 1985, en medio del caos al final de una guerra civil de 35 años y persecución religiosa, se estableció en la ciudad de Guatemala para satisfacer las necesidades religiosas y necesidades temporales de aquellos que apenas podían permitírselo.

Nuestra misión en Guatemala comenzó promoviendo vocaciones al sacerdocio, llevando la buena noticia de Jesús a los marginados en diferentes zonas del país, posteriormente Dios nos bendijo con espíritu misionero expandiendo nuestra misión a otros países.

La Fraternidad Misionera de María es una Sociedad de vida Religiosa con derecho diocesano dentro de la Iglesia Católica Romana dedicada a educar y ordenar a jóvenes para llevar las buenas nuevas y los sacramentos a los católicos marginados del mundo. Como Misioneros, estamos dedicados a las necesidades de los pobres, promoviendo vocaciones a la vida religiosa, preparando jóvenes para el ministerio laico dentro de la Iglesia.

La Casa Madre de la Fraternidad está ubicada en la Ciudad de Guatemala, Centroamérica.

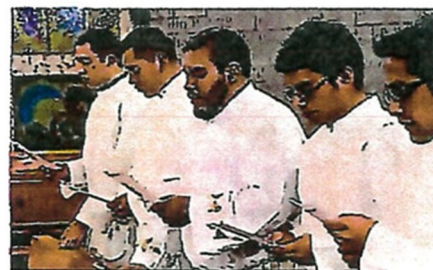
Este año contamos con 65 seminaristas en diferentes niveles de formación en nuestro seminario en la ciudad de Guatemala. Contamos con 168 sacerdotes misioneros sirviendo en 60 misiones, 41 diócesis en 11 países. Los países en donde la Fraternidad tiene presencia misionera son: Panamá, Perú, Ecuador, Venezuela, Honduras, Belice, Guatemala, Canadá, Italia, Kenia y en los Estados Unidos, (Diócesis de San Bernardino California y Arquidiócesis de Milwaukee). Estamos comprometidos a la Iglesia Universal para seguir formando a los jóvenes para el sacerdocio, y para llevar la buena noticia a los pobres. Nuestros retos son muchos, ya que no contamos con un apoyo económico mensual o anual de ninguna institución de la Iglesia Católica en Guatemala. Por ahora, la pandemia ha resultado en una reducción significativa de las solicitudes de misiones en todo el mundo, lo que tiene un grave impacto en nuestro presupuesto para este año y el próximo. Nuestro presupuesto anual por seminarista es de \$3,500. Buscamos fondos para apoyar nuestro programa de formación en el seminario en Guatemala, la mayoría de nuestros estudiantes provienen de familias pobres y de origen maya en Guatemala. Como resultado de la pandemia, en este momento no todos los maestros pueden enseñar de manera presencial en el seminario. Tuvimos que implementar nuevas estrategias en las habilidades de aprendizaje y enseñanza, hemos mejorado la señal de WIFI en nuestros edificios académicos en el seminario, pero aún necesitamos más mejoras para continuar brindando un alto nivel de educación a nuestros seminaristas; muchos de ellos provienen de áreas remotas de Guatemala donde no tienen acceso a internet. También tenemos una gran necesidad de apoyar nuestras misiones en Kenia, Perú y Venezuela. Gracias por su apoyo a la Fraternidad Misionera de María y a las Misiones de la Iglesia Universal. Dios te bendiga.

### Bautismo
