There will be only 2 vessels (a ciborium with altar breads and a cruet with wine) that will be presented in the offertory, but more than 2 people can take part in the offertory procession. Please see the form on the parish website to sign-up as the gift bearers for a particular Mass. Gift bearers are asked to check in at the greeter's table 10 minutes before Mass to confirm their attendance. The bread and the wine - "the fruit of the earth and the work of human hands" - represent the "stuff" of our lives that we offer in thanksgiving to God and ask to be transformed for God's glory in the Eucharistic sacrifice. "Bringing up the gifts" is a way to offer our intentions and unite them to the offering of Christ. Please consider bringing up the gifts if you have requested the intention for the Mass.
