June 19 - Solemnity of Corpus Christi - National Eucharistic Revival Begins

Procession, Litany of the Holy Eucharist, and Benediction after the 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Masses

This year's celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord, on June 19, 2022, also marks the inauguration of a three-year National Eucharistic Revival called for by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. The goal of the Eucharistic Revival is to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. The Archdiocese will begin this period of revival with a Solemn Mass at 11:00 a.m. at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul (18th and the Benjamin Franklin Parkway) followed by a Eucharistic Procession to Saint Patrick Church at 20th and Locust Streets where there will be Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament at 2:00 p.m. At St. Charles, on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, after the 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Masses we will have a Eucharistic Procession, weather permitting, from the Church to the Grotto where we will pray the Litany of the Holy Eucharist and have Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. All liturgical ministers, altar servers, First Communicants and Confirmandi are invited to wear their outfit and participate in the procession.




