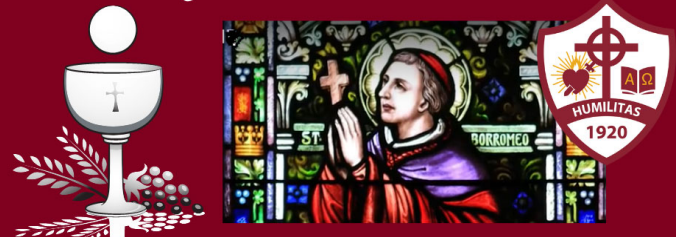

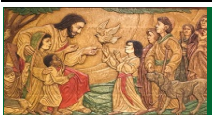

Baptisms will be celebrated in English at 2:00 p.m. on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month and during the 10:00 a.m. Mass on the 4th Sunday of the month. The date of the baptism can be set after baptismal preparation for parents and godparents and letters of eligibility for sponsors have been completed. Baptismal Preparation includes on-line videos and an in-person session. One of the nine children, he grew up very close to God and the Catholic faith but fell away from the Church for 6 years while a teenager and young adult. At the age of 21, he re-discovered God while living in the Holy Land and joining a community of the Neocatechumenal Way. His return to the faith coincided with God's calling him to the priesthood: *Go and Announce what I have done with you.*

During Forty Hours, all parish meetings are suspended so that we, as a parish family, may be re-focused on the Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith. Please spend some quiet time with our Eucharistic Lord in these days and enjoy the reflections of Fr. Francesco who will preach the Holy Hour on Sunday evening and the evening Masses for the Solemnity of All Saints, Monday and Tuesday.

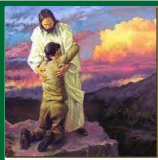
