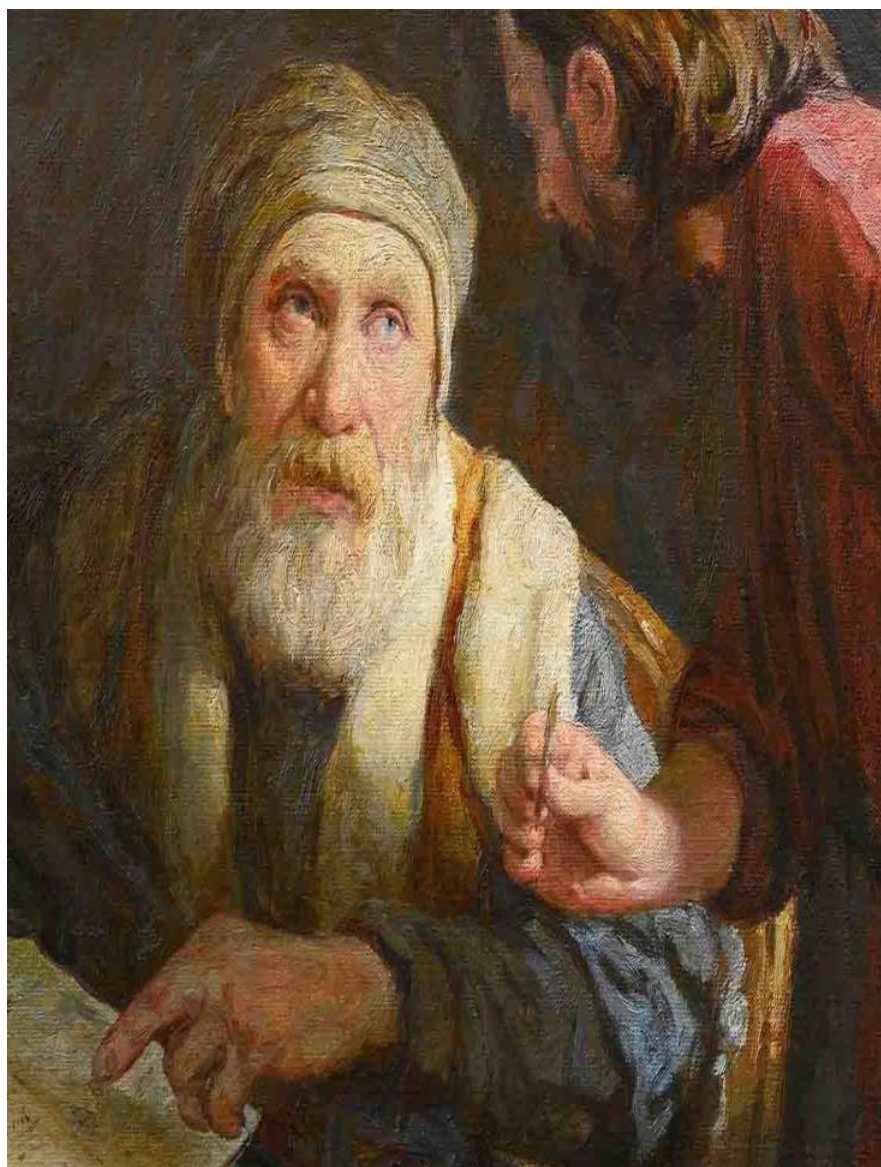

In order to be a sponsor and/or to receive a Letter of Eligibility for Sponsorship, one must be a practicing Catholic at least 16 years old, who has received all of the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation), if married, married validly in the Catholic Church, or, if not married, living a life in harmony with the faith. 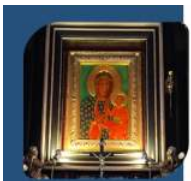

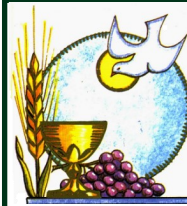

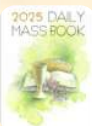


How does one become Catholic or receive the Sacraments as an Adult?

Do you know anybody who is attracted to Catholicism? Or has a restless heart and is seeking answers to questions like, "why am I here?" and "what is the purpose of my life?" Are you a non-Catholic spouse or friend of a Catholic and have ever considered becoming Catholic? Were you baptized or received First Holy Communion but never Confirmed? Do you think something is missing in your life? The O.C.I.A (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) addresses the fundamental questions that arise from the human experience while providing an introduction to the Catholic faith for persons inquiring about or desiring to become Catholic. The course may also serve as instruction and formation in the faith for adult Catholics who lack any of the sacraments. The course is less about doctrine or catechism and more about learning to grow in friendship with Christ through reading of Sacred Scripture, participation in the Mass, and a shared journey within the community of the Church. Sessions will take place Thursday evenings from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. starting on Thursday August 28 in the Rectory. Questions or inquiries can be directed to Fr. O.C.I.A "Team Members" wanted! The model that Jesus gave us for passing on the faith - our relationship with Him - is not through the Catechism and a set of moral norms, but by "sharing life" with others. Jesus didn't say, "read this" or "learn this" but "Come and see" and "follow me" (John 1: 39, 43). The disciples came to discover the meaning of their lives and that Jesus was the Savior through the experience of their friendship with him and by staying with him even when they didn't understand what Jesus was saying. Jesus continues to attract and form disciples through this same method today through his mystical body, the Church. What is needed are not teachers but witnesses - people who demonstrate by their "way" of life that their relationship with Christ is what gives life, all of life, "life" - fullness, meaning, purpose, and direction. If you are interested in journeying with those who have become awakened by an encounter with Christ or are seeking a way for yourself to be renewed in your own relationship with the Lord and to see Him alive in the Church, please consider joining the O.C.I.A "Team". "Blessed are they who mourn, for they shall be comforted"
Matthew 5:4

We grieve because we have loved, and there is no set schedule for grieving the loss of a loved one—it can take months or even years. One never gets over the loss and grief, but one can learn to overcome the loss and grief. We need others to help us during those periods when there does not seem to be an answer to the depression, anger, loneliness, and deep hurt within us. Getting together with others who have been in the same situation allows us to share our thoughts, feelings, memories, and even tears.

If you are grieving the loss of a parent, spouse, child, sibling, or friend, join us and together we can work through the emotions you are experiencing. Since September 2004, the Bereavement Ministry of Our Lady of Calvary parish, a peer group who have suffered the loss of a loved one, have been giving of their time and talent to help others cope with their loss. Please join us for these helpful sessions.

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY sessions are held in the OLC lower church meeting room (enter by way of the ramp on the rectory side of the church) from 7:00 PM to approximately 8:30 PM on the following Tuesday evenings:

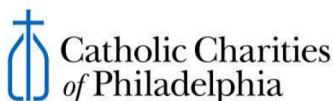

Conozca Sus Derechos

Consejos prácticos para personas con inquietudes migratorias

- ⇒ **Conozca sus derechos:** tiene derecho a permanecer en silencio, negarse a permitir la entrada a su casa sin una orden de registro judicial y solicitar un abogado si es detenido.
- ⇒ **Cree un plan de seguridad familiar:** decida quién cuidará de los niños y administrará las finanzas si alguien es detenido.
- ⇒ **Consulte a un abogado de inmigración:** explore sus opciones legales de acuerdo a su estatus migratorio.
- ⇒ **Regístrese en su Consulado.**
- ⇒ **Memorice información clave:** número de teléfono de familiares, número de registro de extranjero (si tiene uno), número de teléfono del abogado.
- ⇒ **Construya su comunidad:** únase a organizaciones religiosas o comunitarias para obtener apoyo y recursos.

Todas las personas en los Estados Unidos, independientemente de su estatus migratorio, tienen ciertos derechos y protecciones según la Constitución de los Estados Unidos. Esta tarjeta "Conozca sus derechos" fue creada para ayudar a las personas a hacer valer sus derechos y defenderse contra violaciones constitucionales. - **ENTREGUE ESTA TARJETA AL AGENTE.** Si usted está dentro de su casa, muestre la tarjeta por la ventana o pásela debajo de la puerta.

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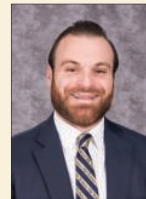
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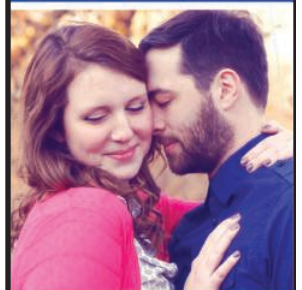
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
